SUMMARY

On March 15, 2009 at approximately 4:30 p.m. deputies from the Rancho Cucamonga Police Station responded to a call of a reported burglary and assault that had occurred the previous night in the 11600 Block of Church Street, in the City of Rancho Cucamonga.

During the investigation, detectives learned from the victim, that the suspect, Joseph Aleman, an acquaintance, forced his way into her residence, physically assaulted her, and then fled the scene. The victim sustained moderate injuries during the assault and received treatment at a local hospital.

A warrant was served at the suspects' residence in the City of Upland. He was subsequently arrested and booked at the West Valley Detention Center on the above felony charges. He is being held in lieu of \$550,000 bail.
