SUMMARY

On April 15, 2010 at approximately 1:59 a.m. deputies assigned to the Rancho Cucamonga Police Station responded to a call of shots fired in the parking lot of Boston's Gourmet Pizza and Pasta. Witnesses reported to deputies that approximately 10 shots were fired and that all involved parties had fled the area. It was also learned that one of the bullets entered an adjacent apartment complex and into a bedroom where two small children were sleeping. The bullet was recovered in the closet and fortunately the children were not struck.

A few moments after 2:00 a.m., a 911 call was received from a male subject at the corner of Vineyard and 4th Street reporting that he had been shot and needed an ambulance. Emergency personnel transported the victim to Arrowhead Medical Center, where he was admitted for treatment of multiple gun shot wounds.

Detectives received a second call by personnel at San Antonio Community Hospital indicating that a victim of multiple gunshot wounds had just been admitted.

Investigators determined that both victims received their injuries at the shooting that had occurred in the area of 4th and Milliken. Detectives also believe that the gunfire is gang related from the Los Angeles area.

The criminal investigation is continuing and anyone that may have been a witness or has any information regarding the crime is asked to call Rancho Cucamonga Police Station at (909) 477-2800.
