#2 Tuitupou, Setaleki 22 year old male, Rancho Cucamonga resident
#3 Pomee, Benedict, 21 year old male, Colton resident

SUMMARY

On March 15, 2010 at approximately 1:45 a.m., deputies assigned to the Rancho Cucamonga Police Station responded to a call at McAlan's Pub and Grill regarding an assault. Deputies learned that three male patrons of McAlan's were assaulted and robbed in the parking lot by three unknown male suspects. Two of the victims were knocked unconscious and one victim had a shattered jaw. A wallet and cell phone were reported stolen. All suspects fled the scene prior to the arrival of deputies.

Detectives investigating the assault were able identify the three suspects as Tuuhetoka Sekona, Setaleki Tuitupou, and Benedict Pomee. On April 14th, search and arrest warrants were served at the residence of Tuuhetoka Sekona and Setaleki Tuitupou. Benedict Pomee was arrested without incident on April 15th. All three suspects were booked into West Valley Detention Center for Robbery, Assault with a Deadly Weapon, Participation in a Street Gang, and a felon in possession of a firearm.
