SUMMARY

On May 31, 2010 at approximately 5:26 p.m., a family returning to their home in the 10000 block of Sinclair Street found an intruder inside. The homeowner tackled the intruder, attempted to hold him down, but the suspect fought to break free, biting the victim on his finger. A next door neighbor heard the altercation, and came to assist in helping contain the suspect until deputies arrived. The suspect, who was identified as Joshua Kaner, was found with the victims' property and arrested.

During the investigation, deputies learned that Kaner, who lived in the neighborhood, had been going door to door to find out which neighbors were home and which neighbors were away. Deputies conducted a search at Joshua Kaner's residence and found property identified as belonging to owners of a residence on McLennan Street.

Deputies responded to the McLennan Street home and found that it too had been burglarized. All property was returned to its rightful owners.

Joshua Kaner was booked at West Valley Detention Center on Burglary and Assault charges.
