SUMMARY

Victim was walking by herself south on Haven Avenue, approaching Creekbridge Street. The victim saw the suspect vehicle pass her going north on Haven Avenue, then make a u-turn at Baseline Road. The suspect drove south on Haven Avenue and turned to follow the victim on Creekbridge Street.

The suspect pulled up next to the victim and told her to "Get in." When the victim did not follow his demands, he repeated himself and started to open the driver's door. Fearing for her safety, the victim ran to a nearby house where she sought help. While talking to the witness, she saw the suspect approach the witness house from a different direction. When the suspect saw the victim talking to the witness, the suspect turned and fled the area.
