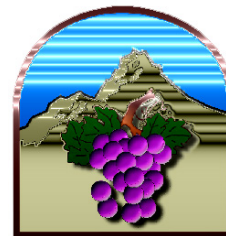

Date/Time Occurred: April 1, 2009 at approximately 8:40 p.m.

Crime or Incident: PC 245 (a) (1), Assault with a Deadly Weapon

Location: 10576 Foothill Blvd. Rancho Cucamonga 91730 (Target)

Involved parties: Daniel Camacho, 25 years old, resident of Fontana

Justin Williams, 32 years old, resident of Anaheim

SUMMARY:

On April 1, 2009 at approximately 8:40 p.m., deputies assigned to the Rancho Cucamonga Station were called to the parking lot of the Target store located on Foothill Boulevard, regarding a possible stabbing. During the investigation, it was learned that Daniel Camacho was a passenger in a vehicle that cutoff Justin Williams' vehicle. Justin Williams became upset screaming profanities at Camacho's direction as he was driving next to the vehicle on Foothill Boulevard.

Williams sideswiped Camacho's vehicle and swung his fist in Camacho's direction. Camacho accelerated in an effort to avoid Williams. Williams reappeared and pulled his vehicle next to Camacho's vehicle. Williams ordered Camacho to stop his vehicle as they were in transit by showing him the palm of his hand. Camacho removed a pocket knife from his person, lunged out the rear passenger seat window and in a slicing motion cut Williams. Camacho proceeded westbound on Foothill Boulevard and entered the Target shopping center. Williams followed the suspect into the Target shopping center and contacted deputies at the location.

An infield line-up positively identified Camacho as the suspect yielding the knife. Camacho was arrested and booked at the West Valley Detention Center for Penal Code 245(a)(1), Assault with a Deadly Weapon. Criminal Charges are pending review of the police report by the San Bernardino County District Attorney's Office. Williams was transported to Loma Linda Medical Center for medical attention due to his injuries.
