SUMMARY

On Friday, February 13, 2009, at approximately 9:30 p.m. deputies from the Rancho Cucamonga Police Station responded to a report of shots fired in the 6000 Block of Fontaine Place in the City of Rancho Cucamonga.

Upon arrival, Deputies found a subject lying in a front yard of the residence with multiple gunshot wounds. The subject was transported by helicopter to a local area hospital for medical treatment.

During the course of the investigation, detectives determined that the gunshot victim had been involved in a narcotic related transaction inside a vacant residence and was subsequently robbed and shot.

Suspects Myles, Davis, and Johnson were identified as having involvement in the narcotics deal. All three suspects were subsequently arrested at various locations in the city of Rancho Cucamonga and transported to the West Valley Detention Center. Myles was booked on robbery and attempted murder charges. He is being held in lieu of \$1,400,000 bail. Johnson and Davis were booked on attempted murder charges with their bail being set at \$5,000,000.
