### SUMMARY

On May 6, 2010, at approximately 1:10 a.m. a Rancho Cucamonga Deputy, while responding to a call in the area of Alta Cuesta and Via Ladera, witnessed a shot being fired from the passenger side of a vehicle that was speeding by his police unit. Fortunately, the deputy was not struck by the gunfire and was able to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle. The driver was identified as Ashley Gonzalez and the passenger as Adrian Cardenas. Deputies located a loaded .25 caliber pistol along with additional ammunition inside the vehicle.

Adrian Cardenas, a documented gang member, was arrested without incident and booked at West Valley Detention for Attempted Murder, a Felon in Possession of a Firearm, Shooting at a person from a vehicle, and for violating the terms of his Probation.

Ashley Gonzalez was arrested and booked at West Valley Detention Center for Willful Discharge of a Firearm and for Driving while shots were being fired from her vehicle.
