SUMMARY

On August 9, 2009, at approximately 7:30 p.m., deputies assigned to the Rancho Cucamonga Police Station responded to a call of a possible burglary in process at a residence in the 11000 block of SouthHampton Court.

When deputies arrived at the residence, they found a male suspect to still be inside. Upon seeing law enforcement, the suspect fled on foot through numerous backyards and streets. During the short pursuit and apprehension of the suspect, later identified as Luis Mulet, three deputies received minor injuries.

Luis Mulet was arrested and booked at the West Valley Detention Center for PC 459 Burglary, and PC 148.10(A) Resisting a Police Officer. He is on parole for similar charges and is being held without bail.
