DATE/TIME: March 30, 2009 at approximately 2:00 a.m.

INCIDENT: PC 464 Burglary with explosives, PC 459 Burglary, PC 182(A)(1) Conspiracy to commit a crime

LOCATION: 11801 Lark Drive, Rancho Cucamonga

SUSPECT(S): (1) Lorenzo Crisp, 44 year old male, (2) Chelsea Crisp, 33 year old female, both residents of Moreno Valley

VICTIM(S): Coca-Cola Bottling Company

SUMMARY: On Monday, March 30, 2009, at approximately 2:00 a.m., deputies from the Rancho Cucamonga Police Station responded to a call for service at Rancho Cucamonga High School located at 11801 Lark Drive in Rancho Cucamonga. While at the school, deputies made contact with a suspect identified as Lorenzo Crisp. Lorenzo was found in possession of a large iron bar and a black backpack containing an acetylene blow torch and approximately \$100 in U.S. currency.

During the investigation, it was discovered that the suspect had used the acetylene blow torch and the iron bar to force entry into an enclosed Coca-Cola vending machine to steal the cash. Chelsea Crisp was contacted at her vehicle parked just south of the school acting as a look-out. Both suspects were arrested for burglary using an acetylene torch and conspiracy to commit a crime. Lorenzo Crisp who was currently out on bail on an unrelated charge has been linked to at least 4 other burglaries at local schools in Rancho Cucamonga.

The suspects were booked at the West Valley Detention Center. Lorenzo Crisp is currently being held on \$501,000 bail. Chelsea Crisp is currently being held on \$50,000 bail.
