### SUMMARY

On April 23, 2010, Deputies were dispatched to an altercation in the area of 11815 Foothill Blvd, the parking lot of Loco Cantina & Grill. Deputies observed approximately 5-10 individuals involved in a physical fight in the parking lot directly in front of the restaurant. Multiple subjects complained of cuts, scrapes and bruising as a result of the fight. Multiple subjects were decontaminated due to the use of pepper spray.

Approximately ten minutes after the dispersing of the fight, Deputies were dispatched to an unknown injury traffic collision a short distance from the restaurant location. The collision was located at Rochester Ave / 6<sup>th</sup> St.

Adam Hernandez, identified as the driver of an Infinity coupe traveling south bound in the north bound lanes of Rochester Ave, collided head on with a Chevrolet Suburban. Two passengers of Hernandez were transported to area hospitals for a complaint of pain including a possible fractured clavicle. The driver of the Suburban was also taken to an area hospital for a possible fractured foot. Statements from the occupants of the Infinity indicated they had been at Loco Cantina & Grill and were attempting to leave the area due to the fight. Hernandez displayed objective indicators of being intoxicated. Preliminary breath tests indicated a blood alcohol content of over two times the legal limit. Hernandez was treated at an area hospital for a possible broken arm; he was then released transported and booked into the West Valley Detention Center for CVC 23153(a) Dui Causing Injury and CVC 23153(b) Blood alcohol level above .08% causing injury.
