SUMMARY

A search warrant was executed on April 16, 2010 at approximately 10 p.m. in the 8000 block of Archibald Avenue by deputies assigned to the Gang Unit of the Rancho Cucamonga Police Department. Deputies located a stolen Lincoln Navigator, dangerous weapons and a substance believed to be methamphetamine. The six suspects were documented members of a local criminal street gang.

Gregory Martinez Jr. was booked in for possession of a dangerous weapon. Thomas Perez was booked for possession of stolen property, possession of a controlled substance for sale, and for violating the terms of his parole. Eva Martinez, Gabriel Perez, and Gregory Martinez Sr. were arrested and charged with possession of stolen property. The 17 year old juvenile (name withheld) was booked at West Valley Juvenile Detention Center for possession of stolen property.
