### SUMMARY

On June 28, 2009 at approximately 5:50 p.m., deputies assigned to the Rancho Cucamonga Police Station responded to the 8000 block of Helms Avenue in reference to the theft of a 3 month old Chihuahua puppy. During the investigation, it was learned that an unknown female had taken the puppy from the owners' front yard. A witness was able to provide deputies with a description of the female suspect and the license plate number of her vehicle. Deputies identified and arrested Lillian Rodriguez at approximately 10:45 p.m. She was booked into West Valley Detention Center for PC 487(e), Grand Theft Dog. The Chihuahua was safely returned to the owner.
