SUMMARY: At approximately 7:17 p.m. on Wednesday, March 4, 2009, deputies with the Rancho Cucamonga Police Department and Rancho Fire personnel responded to a minor injury traffic collision on Haven Avenue near Nineteenth Street. The driver of a blue Hyundai SUV was stopped for a red light on Haven and was rear ended by the driver of a red Chevrolet sedan.

Further investigation revealed the driver of the red sedan, Deanna Anderson, was driving while impaired by alcohol. She was arrested and booked at the West Valley Detention Center for felony DUI.

Carol Lee Santa Cruz was transported to a local area hospital for treatment of minor injuries.
