#2 Marisa Ruiz, 28 year old resident of Ontario

**Victim:** Three employees of Game Stop

### SUMMARY

On December 27, 2009, at approximately 10:45 p.m., an employee of Game Stop, while outside emptying a trash can, was approached by an unknown male. The male pulled out a rifle and ordered the employee back inside the store. Once inside the store, the suspect ordered three additional employees to the store room. The suspect fired off several rounds, but fortunately no one was injured. The suspect attempted to duct tape the employees, but one of the employees began to fight back and was eventually able to push the suspect out of the store. The suspect fled the area in a vehicle.

Employees of Game Stop immediately called 911 and were able to provide a description of the suspect and his vehicle. Deputies located the suspect, later identified as Sean Murphy, at Foothill Boulevard and Spruce Street. Deputies found the weapon and duct tape used in the attempted robbery inside Murphy's vehicle. Further investigation revealed that the suspect Sean Murphy had planned the robbery with the Assistant Manager of Game Stop, Marisa Ruiz.

Sean Murphy was arrested and booked at West Valley Detention Center for Attempted Robbery, Assault with a Firearm and Kidnapping. Marisa Ruiz was arrested and booked at West Valley Detention Center for Attempted Robbery and Conspiracy to Commit a Crime.
