SUSPECTS: #1: Male Juvenile, a resident of Rancho Cucamonga
#2: Debbie Acevedo, 46 year old female, resident of Rancho Cucamonga

SUMMARY:

On Monday, March 9th, 2009, at approximately 6:00 p.m., deputies from the Rancho Cucamonga Police Station assigned to the Multi-Enforcement Team's Crime Free Multi-Housing Unit conducted a narcotic investigation at the Reserve at Empire Lakes Apartments located at 9650 Milliken Avenue.

During the investigation, the above named suspects were arrested for being involved in narcotic activity. The charges ranged from possession of marijuana with intent to sell, possession of narcotics for sale and operation of a drug house. Through investigative leads the juvenile was suspected of selling marijuana and hallucinogenic drugs in the area of Alta Loma High School. The suspects were booked at the West Valley Detention Center and West Valley Juvenile Hall and the cases were submitted to the District Attorney's office for filing of felony charges.

The property management at the Reserve at Empire Lakes Apartments is associated with the Rancho Cucamonga Crime Free Multi-Housing Program, a program that targets problem tenants who commit crimes in multi-housing complexes. The tenants of the apartment where narcotics were being sold will be evicted, making the apartments a healthier and safer place for the residents to live, improving the quality of life for all of the residents of Rancho Cucamonga.
