SUMMARY:

Since January 2009, the City of Rancho Cucamonga has seen a series of daytime residential burglaries. Approximately twenty five burglaries have been committed by the suspects knocking on the front doors of houses. If the door is not answered; the suspects "kick" in the doors of the residences. Detectives from the Rancho Cucamonga Police Department have been fervently working these cases to identify and arrest the criminals involved. As this type of crime appears to be a "new trend", it is essential that citizens are aware of what is going on in their own neighborhoods, to report any suspicious vehicles or people by calling the police immediately. It is also helpful to law enforcement to take note of vehicle descriptions and license plate numbers.

On April 14, 2009, at approximately 9:20 a.m. deputies assigned to the Rancho Cucamonga Police Station responded to a call of a suspicious vehicle in the area of Candlewood and Lockhaven. While conducting a check of the area, Deputy Long observed the above named suspects loading a large flat screen television into a parked vehicle. In Deputy Long's attempt to question the subjects, one of the subjects fled on foot. Through further investigation, it was learned that a residential burglary had just occurred in the 7500 block of Center Avenue in the City of Rancho Cucamonga. Taken into custody for burglary, were Edward Scott and the 16 year old male juvenile. The suspects are believed to be responsible for several "door kick" residential burglaries in the city of Rancho Cucamonga. The suspects are members of a black street gang called "Edgemont Criminals".

Detectives were able to identify the third suspect as Craisean Evans. Evans was arrested on April 17th, along with his girlfriend, Selinchua Abdul Aziz, a 19 year old resident of Banning. A search warrant was then conducted at Selinchua Abdul Aziz's residence in Banning. Stolen property was recovered at her residence. Enoble Abdul Aziz, 24 years old and Muadeeb Abdul Aziz, 22 years old, were arrested for PC 186.22(A) participation in a criminal street gang.
