SUMMARY

On April 8, 2009 at approximately 12:45 a.m., deputies from the Rancho Cucamonga Police Station responded to an emergency call regarding a strong armed robbery that had just occurred at a residence in the south western area of the city of Rancho Cucamonga. The victim, a 68 year old female, stated that she was followed home from San Manuel Indian Casino and robbed of her purse which contained \$500 in cash along with other personal property.

During the three month long investigation, Detectives have been able to identify, arrest, and book the four men suspected of committing the crime. On May 12th, suspect Shamarion Hopson was arrested, June 4th Jamari Carter was arrested, and on July 9th, Deandre Pierce and Cedric Terry were arrested. All suspects were transported and booked into West Valley Detention Center. Detectives also located evidence linking the suspects to robberies that occurred in the cities of Colton and San Bernardino in the months of March and April. As of today's date we have had two additional arrests from the on-going investigation. The cases will be handled through Rancho Cucamonga Superior Court.
