**Suspect:** Zachery Joseph Quiroz, 24 year old Fontana resident

### SUMMARY

On May 6, 2010, at approximately 2:11 a.m., deputies responded to a call of a vehicle burglary that had just occurred in the area of Hillside Road. Deputies learned that several vehicle burglaries had just occurred in the area and witnesses were able to give a description of a vehicle being driven by the suspect.

Deputies located and attempted to stop a vehicle that was driving erratically and matched the suspects' description. Deputies cornered the vehicle in a cul-de-sac and identified the driver as Zachery Joseph Quiroz. A baseball bat embedded with glass and stolen property was found inside the vehicle. Deputies believe that Zachery Joseph Quiroz is responsible for committing half a dozen vehicle burglaries in Rancho Cucamonga on May 6<sup>th</sup>.

Some of the recovered stolen property has been returned to the rightful owners; however, detectives are looking for the owners of several other items. Detectives are asking anyone that may have had their car burglarized on May 6<sup>th</sup> in the city of Rancho Cucamonga, to contact the Rancho Cucamonga Police Station at (909) 477-2800. Please provide the following information: date and address of the vehicle burglary and a description of the property that was stolen.

Zachery Joseph Quiroz was booked at West Valley Detention Center for Burglary and Receiving Known Stolen Property.
