### SUMMARY

On September 16, 2009, at approximately 6:17 a.m., deputies assigned to the Rancho Cucamonga Police Station responded to calls of two male subjects suspected of burglarizing vehicles in the areas of Wilson and San Sevaine Road in the City of Rancho Cucamonga. As deputies arrived on scene, the two suspects fled through backyards jumping walls. Witnesses were able to provide deputies with descriptions of the suspects, and an extensive search of the area was conducted which resulted in the apprehension of Juan Lozano and Samuel Avalos. Lozano was found hiding in a shed and Avalos was arrested as he was walking down Cherry Avenue. The suspects were taken into custody and booked at West Valley Detention Center on PC 459 Burglary.

Stolen property which included cameras, cell phones, GPS systems, and money were recovered during the search for the suspects.
