SUMMARY

On August 24, 2009 at approximately 10:45 a.m., a 24 year old female walking with her two young children on Red Oak Street, noticed she was being followed by a man driving a red Honda. The man, later identified as Robert Ramirez Solorio, attempted to pull the victim towards his car by grabbing her arm. The victim was able to pull away, but Solorio continued to follow her as she walked. Witnesses driving on Red Oak asked the victim if she needed help and called 911. The witnesses were able to provide deputies with the license plate number and a description of the suspect.

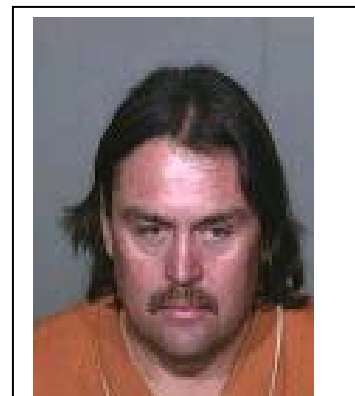
Detectives located the suspect, Robert Solorio, at his residence in the city of Bloomington. He was then arrested and booked at West Valley Detention Center on felony attempted kidnapping.
