SUMMARY

On May 25, 2010, at approximately 7:50 a.m., two unidentified black male adults described as wearing security clothing, approached a residence in the 7000 block of Beryl Street asking the homeowner if she needed pool service. When the homeowner said no, the males quickly returned to their black sports utility vehicle and left.

Approximately 10 to 15 minutes later, another residence on Beryl Street was approached by two unidentified black males. The occupant of this residence was asleep and did not answer the door. The suspects entered the home through a small open bathroom window. The victim confronted the intruders and began chasing them. One of the suspects threw a large screwdriver at the victim and then locked themselves in the bathroom exiting through the same open window.

Witnesses reported seeing the suspects jump over a brick wall leaving the area in a black sports utility vehicle with a white magnetic sticker on the door. Deputies located the suspects' vehicle less than one mile away at the corner of London Avenue and Victoria Street. The suspects were identified as Jonathan Flowers, Matthew Mitchell and David Walker. Flowers, Mitchell, and Walker were arrested and booked at West Valley Detention Center for Burglary, Residential Robbery and Conspiracy to Commit a Crime.
