WHAT IS A POLICE EXPLORER?

Explore the field of law enforcement by volunteering time helping your community. A police explorer is a young adult who is interested in law enforcement, who learns self-respect, self-confidence, discipline and how to effectively deal with others.

Exploring is for those who respect both law and order, and want to make a difference in their community. Today's law enforcement is looking for active men and women to continue its heritage.

WHAT DOES AN EXPLORER DO?

An explorer is trained in aspects of law enforcement to provide the explorer with a basic understanding of the services provided by a public safety agency. The training will give the explorer a better understanding of themselves, others, and what a career in law enforcement involves.

An explorer receives experience in:

- Patrol (Ride-a-long)
- Traffic Control
- Report Writing
- Communication
- Crime Prevention
- Community Relations
- Regular classes and instruction
- Completion of an approved academy is mandatory

In addition, the explorer will participate in post activities such as:

- Parades
- Field trips to other agencies
- Trips to amusement parks and other activities
- Sports tournaments
- Special events and details
- And other activities as planned

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

Police exploring can be a first step in a successful law enforcement career. Once accepted into the post it is the explorer's responsibility to attain the required mental, emotional, and physical skills necessary for a position in law enforcement.

Police explorer requirements are:

Age: Must be 14½ years of age and a freshman in high school, up to 21 years of age.

Weight: Proportionate to height

Education: Must maintain a 2.0 GPA and have good attendance or have a high school diploma or GED if applicable.

Conduct: Must have no felony convictions. Good personal conduct is essential. A records check and an extensive background check will be performed for all applicants.

Permission: All applicants under 18 years of age must have parental consent and support to participate.
